About the Bible Teacher

Richard Phillips' preaching represents the biblical work of standing against the worldly attitudes of today. He conveys the authority of God and the Scriptures in his preaching—something that is often lacking in preaching today. *God's Living Word* features weekly exposition where God's Word is spread and brought bear on our lives.

Richard Phillips is an Alliance Council member and senior minister of Second Presbyterian Church in Greenville, SC (PCA). He previously served as minister of preaching at Tenth Presbyterian Church in Philadelphia. He served under James Boice, teacher of *The Bible Study Hour* and then along side of Philip Ryken, teacher of *Every Last Word*. He is also a board member of the Alliance of Confessing Evangelicals and is chair of the Philadelphia Conference on Reformed Theology.

An officer in the United States Army for thirteen years, Phillips commanded tank units and later served as assistant professor of leadership at West Point before resigning with the rank of major to enter the ministry. He holds degrees from the University of Michigan, the Wharton School of Business and Westminster Theological Seminary.

Rev. Phillips is the author of numerous books, including his most recent, *Holding Hands, Holding Hearts*, co-written with his wife Sharon, *Chosen in Christ, Faith Victorious, Turning Back the Darkness*, and *What Is the Lord's Supper?* Rev. Phillips and his wife live in Coral Springs, FL with their five children, Hannah, Matthew, Jonathan, Helen, and Lydia.
